GLENCOE PARK DISTRICT
Storage Permit, Terms and Conditions, and Waiver and Release of All Claims

The undersigned boat owner (hereafter "Owner") hereby makes application for a permit to store the boat described on the Boat Permit Application and in consideration for this permit agrees to comply with the below terms, and all applicable rules, regulations and laws governing the use of the facility. Owner further agrees that in the event of his/her failure to abide by the Rules and Regulations for Perlman Park on his/her part or of any person occupying or authorized to use his/her boat, that this permit is subject to immediate suspension at the sole discretion of the Glencoe Park District.

Permit Terms

I. NO ASSUMPTION OF CARE, CUSTODY OR CONTROL BY PARK DISTRICT

Owner is storing the boat at Owner's own risk and understands and agrees that by permitting Owner to store the boat on the Park District Property, the Park District is not assuming the care, custody or control of the boat. Further, this agreement is not intended to establish, create, or impose any bailment or joint ownership, care, or control of the boat or any other personal property of the boat owner.

II. USE OF PARK DISTRICT PROPERTY BY OWNER

Owner is hereby authorized to have access to and use of Park District property for the storage of the boat, provided, however, that this use is subject to change at any time should the Park District determine it needs the Property for its own uses or for any other reason deemed appropriate in the sole discretion of the Park District.

III. INSURANCE AND INDEMNIFICATION

Owner shall, at its own expense obtain and maintain during the term of this agreement, marine/property coverage insuring the boat against loss or damage to the boat by reason of fire, theft, vandalism, collision or other casualty, in an amount not less than the actual cash value of the boat with respect to total loss or damage to the boat. The insurer for the Owner shall agree to waive all rights of subrogation against the Park District, its officers, officials, employees, volunteers and agents for losses arising from this agreement. Further, and to the fullest extent permitted by law, Owner shall protect, indemnify, save, defend and hold harmless the Park District, its officers, officials, volunteers, employees and agents, from and against any and all liabilities, obligations, claims, damages, penalties, causes of action, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney and paralegal fees, which Park District and/or its officers, officials, volunteers, employees and agents may become obligated by reason of any accident, bodily injury, death of person, or loss of or damage to tangible property, arising indirectly or directly in connection with or under, or as a result of this agreement.

IV. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS.

OWNER EXPRESSLY, KNOWINGLY AND VOLUNTARILY WAIVES, RELINQUISHES AND RELEASES THE PARK DISTRICT, ITS OFFICERS, OFFICIALS, VOLUNTEERS, EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS FROM ALL CLAIMS FOR DAMAGES OR LOSS WHICH OWNER MIGHT SUSTAIN AS A RESULT OF ANY AND ALL ACTIVITIES CONNECTED WITH AND ASSOCIATED WITH THIS AGREEMENT AND STORAGE OF OWNER'S BOAT ON PARK DISTRICT PROPERTY (INCLUDING ANY AND ALL DAMAGE TO OR LOSS OF ANY PERSONAL PROPERTY).

IV. SECURITY AND SUPERVISION

Owner is solely responsible for all supervision of the boat and any other personal property, and for taking whatever security measures may be warranted for the safety, security, and protection of the boat and any other personal property stored at the Park District. The Park District shall not be responsible for safeguarding Owner's boat or other personal property. Owner acknowledges that there are certain risks of damage to its property/boat and Owner voluntarily agrees to assume the full risk of any and all damages or loss, regardless of severity or foreseeability, which Owner may incur as a result of this Agreement and specifically, storing Owner's boat or other personal property on Park District property.

V. ASSUMPTION OF RISK

The Glencoe Park District is committed to conducting its recreation programs and activities in a safe manner and holds the safety of participants in high regard. The Glencoe Park District continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions that are designed to protect the participants' safety. However, participants and parents/guardians of minors registering for this program or applying for this permit must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities, especially hazardous recreational activities. You are solely responsible for determining if you or your minor child/ward is physically fit and/or adequately skilled for the activities contemplated by this agreement and/or permit. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity.

Sailing is intended to challenge and engage the physical, mental and emotional resources of each participant. However, despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including hazards and dangers which cannot be foreseen. The very nature of sailing is hazardous and risky, including but not limited to being hit by the boom, getting fingers caught in winches or blocks, inadequate or defective equipment, striking other water craft or stationary objects, falling or being thrown overboard, capsizing, hypothermia, sunburn, sunstroke, high winds, inexperience, failing to wear a life jacket or personal floatation device, failure to monitor weather changes and to adjust the rigging appropriately, horseplay, carelessness, acts of God, inclement weather, inadequate supervision or instruction, and all other circumstances inherent to the sport of sailing and water activities. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the (District/SRA) to guarantee absolute safety.

Owner recognizes and agrees that participation in sailing and use of the Park District property for the purposes permitted by this permit represent hazardous recreational activities for which there are substantial risks of personal injury or death to him/herself and others, and property damage and destruction, which are out of the reasonable control of the Park District, and for which the Owner knowingly and voluntarily assumes all risks and liability, whether such injury, death, damage or destruction occurs on the beach or in the water of Lake Michigan.

VI. AUTHORIZED USERS

This permit is issued for the exclusive use of Owner, including the below identified authorized users living in Owner's household and is to be used for launching only the boat described in the attached application.

VII. ASSIGNMENT AND TRANSFER

This agreement and permit is non-transferable and may not be assigned to any other party without the express written approval of the Glencoe Park District.

VIII. OTHER

Only one boat per family unless space is available. Motor boats are prohibited.

IX. DELINQUENCIES AND ABANDONMENT

OWNER'S BOAT AND ANY OTHER PERSONAL PROPERTY STORED ON PARK DISTRICT PREMISES SHALL BE DEEMED ABANDONED IN THE EVENT: (A) THE BOAT AND ANY OTHER PERSONAL PROPERTY REMAINS ON THE PARK DISTRICT PREMISES WITHOUT A VALID PERMIT FOR GREATER THAN NINETY (90) DAYS; OR (B) THE OWNER BECOMES DELINQUENT IN THE PAYMENT OF ALL APPLICABLE STORAGE FEES. FEES SHALL BE CONSIDERED DELINQUENT IF THE CHARGES REMAIN UNPAID MORE THAN 30 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF THE INVOICE OR ANOTHER DUE DATE ESTABLISHED BY LAW, WHICHEVER IS LATER. BOATS WHICH ARE ABANDONED SHALL BE REMOVED FROM PARK DISTRICT PROPERTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE III C OF THE BOAT REGISTRATION AND SAFETY ACT, 625 ILCS 45/3C-1, ET SEQ. OWNER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT ALL NOTICES ARISING FROM OR REQUIRED BY THIS PERMIT SHALL BE SENT TO THE ADDRESS SET FORTH HEREIN AND OWNER CERTIFIES THE ACCURACY AND COMPLETENESS OF THE ADDRESS, CONTACT AND REGISTRATION INFORMATION PROVIDED.

Please bring your registration receipt with you on your first visit to the boating beach. Upon acknowledgment of receipt, Glencoe Park District staff will provide:

- Beach passes and take beach pass photos for all pass holders present at the time
- Confirm sail tube assignment (if you have a sand space)
- Confirm sail locker assignment
- A boat sticker (we will help affix to your boat)

Delinquent boats

If your boat was stored at the beach for the winter and no payment was received it is currently delinquent. Please contact Bobby Collins at 847-835-7544 or at bcollins@glencoe park district.com immediately as you will not be able to renew your application for summer 2017 without paying the winter storage fees and late fee first. **After 4/15/17 delinquent boats will be removed and spaces will be opened to new boaters on the waitlist.**

Staff has been busy planning the 2017 season, adding new technology and completing facility upgrades to the Boathouse and Beach. Some of the improvements and changes you will notice include:

Registration & Beach Passes

You can now register for your **boat storage and boater passes online** <http://www.glencoe park district.com/Registration> using activity numbers 101791 through 101799 or by searching for keyword "BOAT".

Beach tokens are being replaced with new barcoded beach passes, which will be scanned when you visit the beach. This will give us helpful information about busy times, staffing levels required and general usage of the beach. All beach pass holders will have their photo taken when they receive their pass. It is similar to a gym membership and you will use the same card every year.

Like previous seasons, boaters receive up to 4 passes with your boat storage application. In addition, boaters can now purchase up to an additional **two** passes for \$10 each. These passes will need to be assigned to a specify person and have that persons photo taken. These additional passes are available for purchase at the beach.

Hours of Operation

The Boat House will now be open with limited staff on Fridays throughout the **post-season (August 18th-October 15th)**.

Fleet Upgrades

This season we have made substantial upgrades to our fleet of boats. We purchased a new Zodiac RIB (V-Shaped) powerboat, one new Hobie Getaway with wings, two new monohull sailboats, new paddleboards and kayaks.

Boathouse Upgrades

Inside the Boathouse we are replacing the exterior windows and the existing interior lights with new LED lighting. New floors and doors are currently being installed in both the women's and men's restrooms. The old wooden staff and storage lockers have been replaced with new compact metal lockers. A new AED has also been purchased.

Beach Upgrades

On the beach we added new picnic tables, purchased a new set of Cat Trax and replacement parts, added additional paddleboard storage and we are planning to rebuild the south side kayak and boat rack.

Safety

As a boater of the Glencoe Beach, it is recommended that you have the following safety equipment on your boat when you sail:

- Personal Floatation Devices (PFDs) and weather appropriate clothing for all boaters
- Marine Radio (set to Channel 19a)
- Air horn or sound device

Regattas and Boat Club

The sailing season will also bring our popular regatta events. Participate in challenging, hands-on races set up by beach staff. Each race starts early afternoon and is approximately one hour, followed by a social event. For more information on the Glencoe Boat Club and boating events this summer, please see the enclosed information.

CONDUCT POLICY:

The Glencoe Park District reserves the right to expel or deny participation to any person in any program, event or facility whose behavior interferes or disrupts the quality of those offerings or the staff or other participants engaging in them. Children's parents or guardians shall be notified of the first incident; the second incident shall require the presence of a parent at a meeting with the instructor and a Park District Administrator/Program Manager; a third incident may result in an expulsion of the child from the program, event or facility. Immediate expulsion may occur in the event of severe disciplinary issues.
