IMPORTANT: For you and/or your child to participate in Park District programs and use Park District facilities, you must carefully read both the Waiver and Release and Warning of Risk on this form. Your signature signifies that you agree to these terms and conditions.

WAIVER AND RELEASE: Please read this form carefully and be aware that in signing up for and participating in programs/activities, you will be expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and waiving and releasing all claims for injuries, damages or loss which you might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with said programs/activities (including transportation services/vehicle operation, when provided). I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to participants in these programs/activities, and I voluntarily agree to assume the full risk of any and all injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity, that any minor child/ward or I may sustain as a result of said participation. I further agree to waive and relinquish all claims against the Glencoe Park District and School District 35, including their officials, agents, volunteers, and employees (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Park/School District"), which I may have (or that accrue to me) as a result of participating in these programs/activities. I do hereby fully release and forever discharge the Park/School District from any and all claims for injuries, damages, or loss that I may have or which may accrue to me arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with these programs/activities. If registering via fax, I understand my signature shall substitute for and have the same legal effect as an original form signature. Photos are periodically taken of participants in a class, during a special event or at the District's parks and facilities. Please be aware that these photos are for Park District use only and may be used in the District's publications. I have read and fully understand the above important information, warning or risk, and waiver and release of all claims.

WARNING OF RISK, ICE SKATING AND HOCKEY: The very nature of ice skating is risky, including but not limited to slips and falls, colliding with other players (including being struck from behind), tripping on irregular ice surfaces, cuts from skate blades, and other risks inherent to the sport. Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including but not limited to head injury, neck or back injury, wrist and ankle fractures, and other orthopedic injuries to limbs and joints. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Glencoe Park District to guarantee absolute safety. Open Hockey and Scrub Hockey players over the age of 18 must wear a helmet in order to go onto the ice rink. If there is refusal, the player must sign waiver of liability that the individual is aware of the risk and that the park district will not assume responsibility if an injury occurs. Players 17 and under must wear a helmet or participant will not be allowed onto the rink.

WARNING OF RISK, BEACH: The very nature of swimming and beach/aquatic activities are hazardous and risky, including but not limited to, fatigue and overexertion, poor swimming skills, falling to avoid dangerous areas, failure to follow rules and regulations, swimming outside buoy markers, failure of lifeguards to locate victims and/or delay in emergency response time, horseplay, diving or cannon-balling into shallow water and striking the bottom of the lake, ever-changing and uncertain lake depth and composition, poor supervision or instruction, lack of conditioning, becoming disoriented, striking other swimmers, undertows and dangerous currents, lightning strikes, dangerous objects such as glass and sharp objects hidden beneath the sand, and all other circumstance inherent to aquatic/beach activities and facilities. Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including but not limited to drowning, head/brain injury, and cervical spine injury. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Glencoe Park District to guarantee absolute safety.

CONDUCT POLICY:

The Glencoe Park District reserves the right to expel or deny participation to any person in any program, event or facility whose behavior interferes or disrupts the quality of those offerings or the staff or other participants engaging in them. Children's parents or guardians shall be notified of the first incident; the second incident shall require the presence of a parent at a meeting with the instructor and a Park District Administrator/Program Manager; a third incident may result in an expulsion of the child from the program, event or facility. Immediate expulsion may occur in the event of severe disciplinary issues.

PHOTO AND VIDEO POLICY:

Photos and video footage may be taken of participants in a class, during a special event or at the District's park and facilities. These photographs are for Park District publications, fliers, brochures, posters, or online use. All photos and videos taken on Park District property are for Park District use and become its sole property. If you do not wish to be part of photos or videos, please notify Park District staff at that time. Participation will be denied if the signature of the adult participant or parent/guardian and date are not on the reverse side of this waiver. A signature is required for each participant 18 years old or older and one signature for all minor children/dependents.
