NEW! STORM GIRLS TRAVEL & NEW TRIER FEEDER TEAM GIRLS, GRADES 5-6

If you enjoy the competition of travel basketball and love the game, now is your chance to put your skills to the test! Storm Basketball and New Trier Feeder Basketball are working together to promote and support competitive basketball teams, enhance and improve players' skills, and foster a positive environment of sportsmanship and teamwork. These co-sponsored teams will allow girls to play for their community while still being a part of the New Trier Feeder program.

Tryouts are held prior to the season and team selection is based on ability, attitude and desire. Teams will practice twice per week. In addition to the team fee (\$635), players will pay a \$150 gear fee. Gear includes reversible uniform, bag, sweatshirt, long sleeve shooting shirt and t-shirt. The season runs October through March. Once payment is received to reserve your spot on the team, no refunds will be issued. To reserve a tryout spot, participants must register at no cost through the Glencoe Park District.

GLENCOE TRAVEL TEAM BOYS, GRADES 4-6

Competitive basketball at its best! There are two practices a week determined by the coach and gym availability. Teams play neighboring programs primarily on Saturdays and Sundays, and paid coaches lead all travel teams.

Fee: \$765 (includes a team jersey, shooting shirt, and shorts)

*Players must attend a minimum of two tryouts to be eligible. Parents must be present for the first five minutes on the first tryout day.

Registration and payment are not accepted until teams are chosen. Placement on a team is based strictly on the player's ability and performance during the tryouts. Playing time is not guaranteed. The league fee does not include transportation. Some games may take place over holiday weekends and weeknights.
