Dear Families:

We are pleased to have your child enrolled in the Kinder Korner Camp this summer. Our camp will be held at the Takiff Center, 999 Green Bay Road in Glencoe. Camp begins on June 19th and runs through August 11th, Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Group Blue will be located in Room 228, Green Group will be located in Room 229 and Group Red will be in Community Room 4. Group assignments will be available at the Information Night on June 7th. The Group Blue camp staff are Sonja Anderson, Izzy Kritz and Andrew Meyers. The Group Red camp staff are Cari Resis, Callen Maiworm and Jessica Mitchell. The Green Group staff are Terri Zidron, Sophie Knebelakamp and Anna Marcovici.

Attached you will find the Camper Information Form, Sunscreen Form, and Additional Release Form, as well as important information about the medical conditions of participants. Please note, medical forms are only required for children with allergies or for those children that require medication during camp. **Please complete and return the forms by June 1st.** If your child has allergies or will require medication during the camp sessions, please contact Naomi Garvett, Early Childhood Program manager, by June 1st as well.

****Please note: You child will not be able to start camp without completed paperwork.***

First Day of Camp

On the first day of camp, please park your car and walk your child to his/her camp classroom. Campers and parents will meet the camp instructors. **Children will then stay for the entire camp session and will eat lunch at camp.** At the 1:00pm pick up time, parents will wait in their cars in the **back lot (Takiff Center main entrance)** car pool line. The camp staff will bring the children outside to the cars.

Transportation/Parking:**Second day of camp and thereafter:**

Your child's arrival and departure area will be at the back of the building, at the Takiff Center Main Entrance. A camp counselor will be there in the morning at 9:00 a.m. to greet your child. If you need to speak with the camp teachers or if you are late arriving, please park your car in a designated parking space and walk your child into the building.

If someone other than you will be picking up your child, please send a signed and dated note with instructions. Please remind your alternate pick-up person to bring identification.

The following are some important aspects of the Camp:

- Children should bring a lunch every day, including a drink. We will provide a snack and beverage each morning.
- Starting June 26th, every Monday will be the first beach day. Your child should wear his/her camp T-shirt, bathing suit, and bring a towel and sunscreen on these days. The towel, lunch, and drink should be brought to the beach in a bag. Please clearly label all belongings. Lunches will not be refrigerated.
- T-shirts will be distributed at the camp information night, June 7th. Please be sure your child wears his/her camp shirt on beach and field trip days.

For those campers participating in Kinder Korner Stay-N-Play, you must park and walk inside the building to pick up your child at 3 pm. Please head directly to Community Room 4 for pick up.

Things to Bring the First Day, June 19th:

- Sunscreen, labeled, if you wish to leave it at camp.
