Bid Security is not required for this bid submission.

Proposals will be received until 11:00am on May 28, 2026 at Glencoe Park District, 999 Green Bay Rd., Glencoe, IL 60022 at which time and place all bids will be publicly read. Bids received after closing time will be returned unopened. The public opening is for information only, and is not to be construed as acceptance or rejection of any bid. Award to successful bidder will be made within sixty (60) days.

Contractor is responsible for all measurements, and must personally inspect the site to verify the scope of the work to be bid. The successful bidder will be required to comply with all laws, statutes, regulations, ordinances, rulings or enactments of any governmental authority which are applicable to the work or the project. The Owner has determined that the work is subject to the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act and the successful bidder shall pay Cook County, Illinois Prevailing Wages and shall utilize equal opportunity hiring practices. The Contractor is advised that the Illinois Department of Labor revises the prevailing wage rates and the Contractor/subcontractor has an obligation to check the Department's web site for revisions to prevailing wage rates.
