

Lakefront Advisory Meeting June 17, 2026



History of the Lakefront Advisory Group

Created and authorized by the Glencoe Park District Board of Commissioners in **2011**

Established to provide a formal community sounding board for Glencoe Beach and Lakefront Park.

Comprised of volunteers representing a cross-section of residents, and community stakeholders.

Members serve **four-year terms** and meet approximately **2-3 times per year**.



Purpose of the Advisory Group

Provide Insight

- Offer recommendations based on experience and community needs.
- Help shape policies, projects, and initiatives.

Support Strategic Planning

- Assist in long-term planning.
- Identify opportunities and challenges.

Act as a Liaison

- Serve as a bridge between the community and the Park District.
- Share feedback to guide decision-making.

Collaborate with the District

- Work alongside staff to evaluate proposals and ideas.
- Participate in discussions but do not have a final vote on board decisions.

Advocate in the Community

- Promote awareness of Park District initiatives.
- Encourage community engagement and participation.



What is NOT the Role of the Advisory

Decision-Maker

- Advisory members provide input and recommendations but do not have voting power on final board decisions.

Individual Authority

- Cannot make unilateral decisions or commitments on behalf of the Park District.
- All actions must be reviewed and approved by the full board.

Operational Management

- Does not oversee daily operations, staff, or budget execution.
- Staff and leadership handle implementation and administration.

Personal Agenda Advocate

- Must act in the best interest of the entire community, not personal projects or priorities.

Policy Enforcer

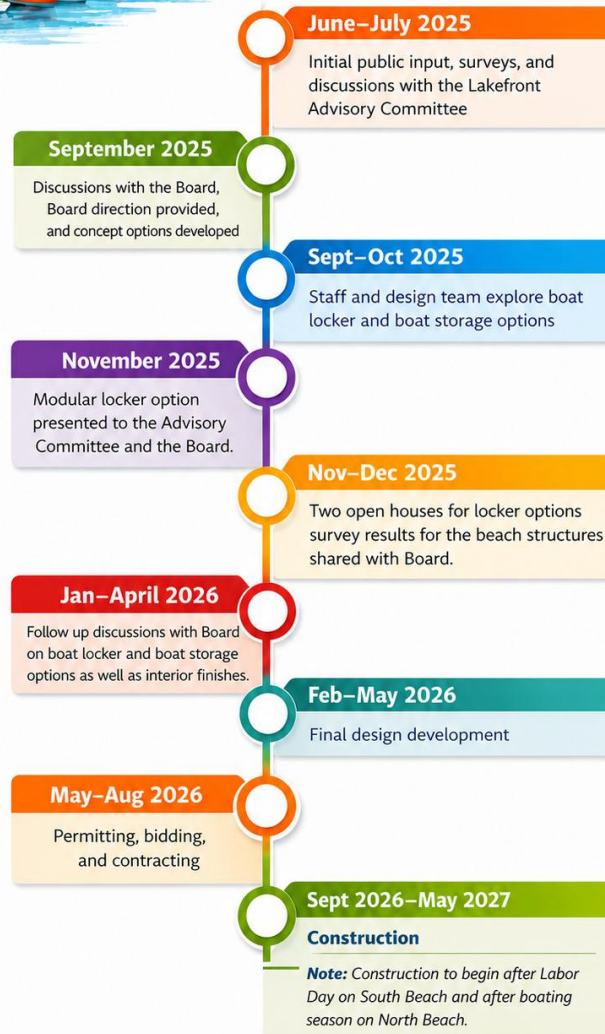
- Recommends policies but does not enforce rules or oversee staff compliance.
- Enforcement is handled by district leadership.



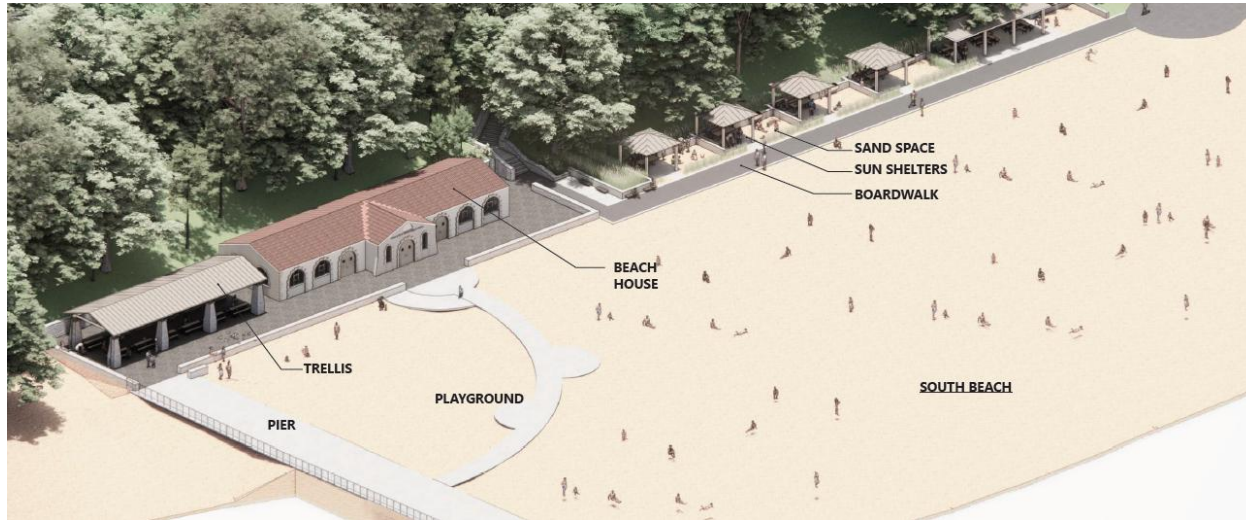

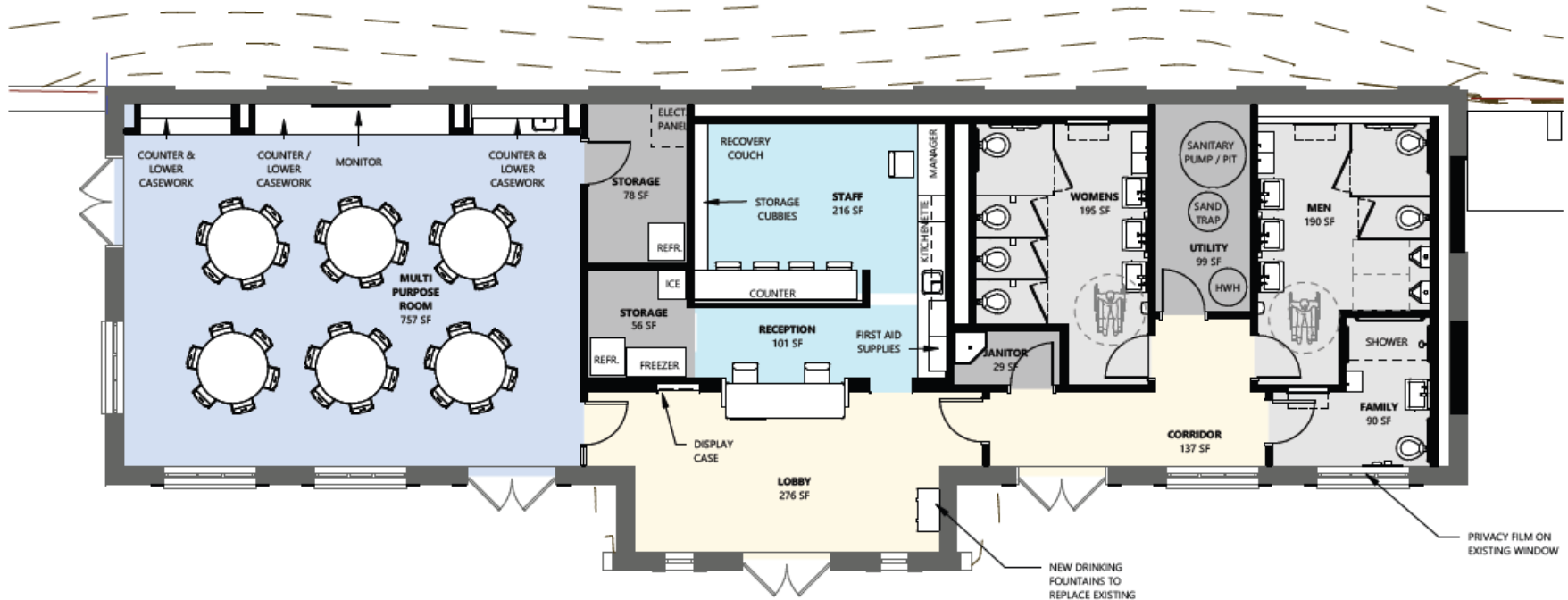

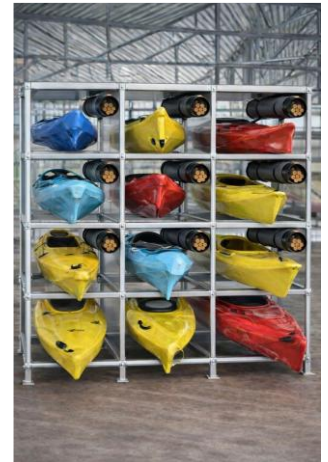

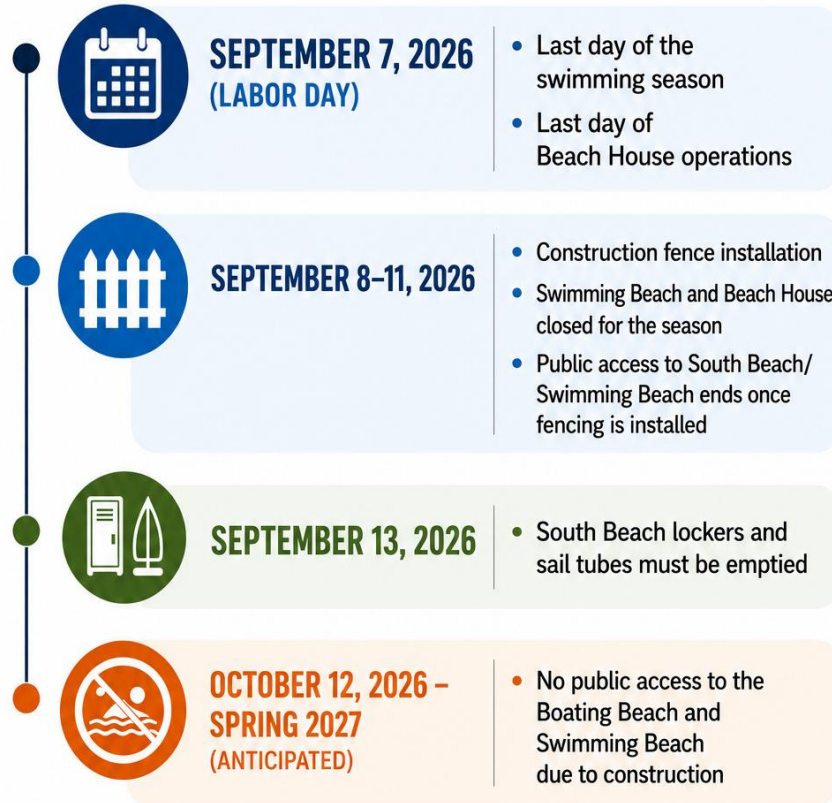

- Ramp access available Saturdays and Sundays, dawn to dusk
- Pedestrian access available through the Hazel Avenue and Park Avenue ramps
